One of the first stages is to get a list out to all of you of the items we need to get the operation started. Many items have already been donated and are not on the list. Dollar amounts are shown to indicate new purchase price.

Items needed for OGT-CND warehouse and shipping facility.

- Enclosed utility trailer, 6 ft. X 10 ft. - \$2,600
- Enclosed utility trailer 6 ft. X 14 ft. - \$4,000
- Used crew cab pickup
- Pallet jack - \$300
- Used fork lift
- 300 ft. of 4 ft. deep pallet racks – do not need to start operation
- Used office chair
- 10 folding chairs
- 4 folding tables – 8 ft.
- Used clothes washer in good shape
- 30 gal. hot water heater \$360
- Used 10 ft. belt conveyor
- Lumber – new or used (2x4, 2x6, 2x8) 4 to 12 ft. long
- Used refrigerator
- Used window air conditioner – 22000 btu or greater
- Water dispenser – hot and cold - \$160
- Bathroom stool (tall) high efficiency - \$250
- Utility sink and faucet - \$100

- Tearing down old cooler adjacent to main building
- Picking up and disposing of wood pieces and general trash

For those of you not familiar with the area, you would take Hwy. 30 east to Shady Bend Rd. Turn south onto Shady Bend Rd. Drive approximately ½ mile.
