VOLUNTEER LABOR

Orphan Grain Train volunteers have given more than 3,000,000 hours of work since 1992, sorting, packing, and shipping items with love and care.

FREIGHT COST

One 40-ft.-long ocean-going freight container will cost between \$7,000 and \$19,000 to ship (an average of \$9 for each Box of relief supplies shipped). Estimated shipping costs for 2010: \$975,000.

Special Projects

"Sponsor a Box"

Orphan Grain Train's avg. cost to ship an apple-box full of relief supplies. = \$9

"Buy a Shunt—Save a Life!"

Over 1,700 lives saved by cerebral shunts sent to Russia: \$140.00 saves a life!

"Adopt An Orphanage"

Sponsor an orphanage in Russia. \$280 per month
 These funds will provide medicine, medical supplies, vitamins, hygienic supplies, school needs, bedding, and some clothing items.

"Project Scrub Bucket"

5-gal. buckets filled with cleaning supplies for flood survivors. \$36 fills a bucket

"Mercy Wraps" for earthquake survivors

Fold sides of towel over a bar of soap, two small packs of tissues, toothbrush & toothpaste, solid deodorant, large comb, and a washcloth. Roll towel length-wise and bind with two large rubber-bands

Wish List

1. Prayers for God's blessings on this ministry.

2. Volunteers

- Call the warehouse to schedule your volunteer time
- We sort clothes and medical equipment year-round.

3. Cash donations to pay for shipping, because:

- The average cost to ship a box of donated goods is \$9;
- The average cost to sponsor a full semi-load shipment overseas is \$9,000.

4. Infants' supplies

- Baby formula (*powdered, soybean-based formula*)
- Cloth diapers
- Layettees
- Stuffed toys

5. Medical Equipment and Supplies

- Bandages, tapes, sponges
- Bed & bath linens, sheets (*adult and crib sizes*)
- Disposable gowns, gloves, & syringes with needles
- Hospital beds (*hand-crank with vinyl mattresses*)
- Prostheses, especially legs
- Walkers, wheel chairs, crutches and canes
- Stethoscopes, blood pressure cuffs, & otoscopes

6. Drug Store items—*almost any non-prescription item you can buy in a drug store—such as:*

- Personal hygiene kits
- Vitamins
- Shampoo
- Sanitary products for women
- Medicine cabinet supplies
- Toothbrushes & toothpaste
- Individual doses: Ibuprofen, Aspirin, Tylenol
- Cough drops
- Disinfectants (*Lysol, etc. -in plastic bottles*)

7. School Supplies

- Back-packs (*student sizes*)
- New coloring books, crayons etc.
- New ballpoint pens & pencils
- Writing paper & notebooks
- Chalk, watercolors and brushes
- Soccer Balls

8. Non-breakable kitchen accessories

- Pots and pans
- Plastic storage containers
- Plastic plates
- Knives, forks, and spoons

9. Clothing (*good used or new*)

- Infant and children's clothes
- Children's shoes & new shoestrings
- **New** underwear (**only**)—all ages and sizes (*Customs officials will levy fines if used underwear is sent in our shipments.*)
- Socks (*good used or new*)
- Men's work clothes are always needed

10. Quilts, comforters, and blankets

- All sizes are needed
- We ship quilts & comforters year-round
