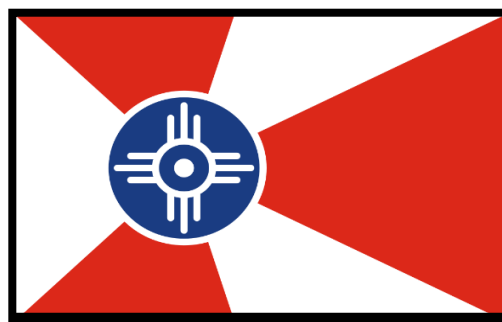

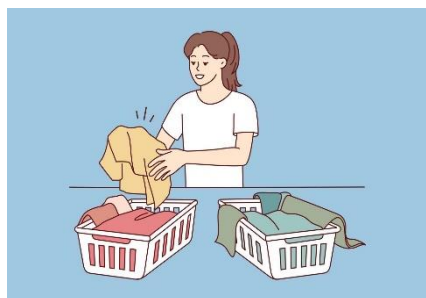
The shipment to Ukraine finally arrived in January 2025.
