# **Volunteer Spotlight**

Orphan Grain Train is powered by volunteers and Wendy Preslan is one reason for our success! Wendy is the new director of our Feminine Hygiene Project.



Wendy has worked for over 20 years in her husband's medical practice, but her absolute favorite job is being President of Stiches of Kindness. Wendy has been

sewing for over 50 years, mostly making clothes for her three daughters when they were young. She also operated a commercial sewing business. Wendy took a break for many years and it wasn't until the pandemic that she got serious again about sewing. During the pandemic, Wendy sewed and donated over 6,000 masks. It was during this time that she realized how much she missed sewing and started doing some research on all the ways that she could continue to sew and give back to the community. In the last 5 years she has supported over 9 other charities by providing hand sewn items. To date, Stitches of Kindness has donated over 15,000 items to include things such as mastectomy pillows, breast wraps, chemo caps, pillowcases, hats, scarves, and blankets just to name a few items.

Last year Stitches of Kindness partnered with Good Neighbors Group and became a program within that organization. Their goal was to reach more volunteers, as well as to encourage community members to donate supplies that may have been collecting dust in their homes. Since becoming partners, Stitches of Kindness has received over 200 yards of donated fabric, as well as other sewing supplies.

It was through Good Neighbors Group that Wendy was introduced to Orphan Grain Train. Originally, she was contacted about making carry bags for the feminine hygiene products. However, there was a bigger need for the actual hygiene kit products and after thoughtful prayer, she decided that she was being led to take on this project.

We are so grateful that Wendy has joined our team of OGT volunteers. With her skill and leadership, our much-needed Feminine Hygiene Project will undoubtedly be a success and a huge blessing to thousands of young women in the African countries which we serve.

## You Can Help Make This Project a Success!



With the help of many hands and hearts, Wendy and her team have donated 80 complete hygiene kits within the last 3 months. Each girl will receive in her kit; 1 carrier, 3 liners, a waterproof pouch to help with washing the liners, a mini pad, crocheted washcloth, soap and a stylish crossbody bag to discreetly carry her supplies.

They have set a very lofty goal of sending 4,000 kits to Liberia and South Sudan, but THEY NEED YOUR HELP!
