Weekly Devotion

Have mercy on me, O God, according to Your unfailing love; according to Your great compassion blot out my transgressions. Wash away all my iniquity and cleanse me from sin. For I know my transgressions, and my sin is always before me. Against You, You only, have I sinned and done what is evil in Your sight, so that You are proved right when You speak and justified when You judge. Surely I was sinful at birth, sinful from the time my

mother conceived me. Surely You desire truth in the inner parts; You teach me wisdom in the inmost place. Cleanse me with hyssop, and I will be clean; wash me, and I will be whiter than snow. Let me hear joy and gladness; let the bones You have crushed rejoice. Hide Your face from my sins and blot out all my iniquity. Create in me a pure heart, O God, and renew a steadfast spirit within me. Do not cast me from Your presence or take Your Holy Spirit from me. Restore to me the joy of Your salvation and grant me a willing spirit, to sustain me. (Ps. 51:1-12)

Failure: Have you ever failed at something? C'mon, you know you have. I have. We all have! I was a pole vaulter in high school. At the District track meet my senior year, I failed to clear the opening height. I failed my first English test in college. And I was an English major! There have been many times when I failed my wife and children. There were times when I failed at my jobs. I could continue, but I think you get the point. Most importantly, we have all failed against God. We have sinned against Him from the day we were born. In fact, we were even sinful at the moment of our conception. Those failures were enough to condemn us eternally. That's God's judgment against sin. Take heart! Despite our sin, God has provided for our forgiveness and salvation. Jesus carried our sins with Him to the cross. We are no longer failures! The prophet writes, *"Return to the Lord your God, for He is gracious and compassionate, slow to anger and abounding in love, and He relents from sending calamity."* (Joel 2:13b). We may be failures by the standards of this world. We may be failures in our own minds and in the sight of others, but we have the clear testimony from Scripture that God's love never fails us. And His love covers up our failures.

Prayer: Forgive and cover our failures, Lord Jesus, even as You promised through Your own death and resurrection. Amen.
